## Signature Campaign of Sewa MP for street vendors



**"Crores of street vendors of the country as we want Central Law which could escape us from harassment of Police and Municipal Corporation, secure their livelihood and organize to cities. Please don't leave us at the mercy of the states, that they will make any Law for us and if they will make, many loopholes would be there."** About 5000 street vendors wrote such message at post card, signed, and posted to Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation Ministry. This campaign was run from 7 March to 20 March by Sewa MP in 19 districts including Indore of MP.



This campaign was called "Do tokari rakhne ka adhikar mile aur samman mile". The main aim of the campaign is to make the Central Law in Country for street vendors and they could get right for livelihood with dignity. Street vendors hope that Central Government will understand their problems and will start the process towards making Central Law.
