

# Duty-free pay strike

CLAIMS of bullying and a pay dispute mean travellers will miss out on Brisbane Airport duty-free as they return from school holidays tomorrow.

A 24-hour strike from 5am and a picket at the international terminal has been called by members of the National Union of Workers against First Duty Free stores. It follows a similar stoppage in Melbourne this week.

National Union of Workers general branch secretary Sam Roberts said seven months of negotiation had broken down with an offer of about a \$13-a-week rise compared with union demands for about \$24.
